# Golf NB Junior Skills Challenge Subsidy Program

The mandate of the Golf NB Junior Skills Challenge Subsidy Program is to support club based junior golf initiatives and programs that will have a significant impact on growing the game of golf in New Brunswick. This document outlines the guidelines for grant applications for 2023.

#### **SUBSIDY INFORMATION**

Eligible facilities may apply for the Golf NB Junior Skills Challenge Subsidy between June 1, 2023, and August 31, 2023, with approval being announced by October 31, 2023. Subsidies will be available to Golf NB partner facilities, in good standing who have no outstanding amounts owing to Golf NB as of the date of the announcement.

#### Golf Canada Learn to Play Curriculum - Base Funding

• Facilities are encouraged to implement the Golf Canada Learn to Play Curriculum. All approved facilities will be eligible for a "Base Funding" amount of up to \$500 with the total amount of approved funding not exceeding \$5,000. (see example under "Distribution of Funds")

#### Golf Canada Junior Skills Challenge Program - Per Player Funding = \$5,000

• To be eligible, players must be included by their club on the Golf Canada Junior Skills Challenge Leaderboard. Facilities will be eligible for "Per Player Funding" of up to \$1,250 with the total amount of funding being distributed not to exceed \$5,000.

Based on the breakdown outline above, eligible partner facilities will be eligible for up to \$1,750 in junior golf funding through Golf NB in 2023.

To apply for grants the following items must be submitted:

- 1) Golf NB Junior Skills Challenge Subsidy Program Application Form Submission Deadline August 31, 2023
- 2) Club Junior Program Player Roster (See Attached)

Submission Deadline – September 30, 2023

In order to be eligible for funding, the "Club Junior Program Player Roster" MUST include.

- o Player Name
- o Player Birthdate
- Player Gender
- o Golf NB / Golf Canada Membership Status
- 3) Year End Summary: (See Attached)
  Submission Deadline August 31, 2023

#### **DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS**

The following outlines the way available funding will be distributed to successful applicants.

**Base Funding** – Each facility that is approved for funding will receive a base subsidy. The base subsidy will be dependent on the number of approved participating facilities and will not exceed \$500 per facility and \$5,000 as a total amount for all participating clubs.

For example. If there are 10 approved facilities then each facility will receive a base subsidy of \$500, while if there are 20 approved facilities then each facility would receive a base subsidy of \$250.

**Per Player Funding** – Approved facilities will receive a per player subsidy for each participant included by the club on the Golf Canada Junior Skills Challenge Leaderboard.

As with the club's base funding, the per player subsidy will see each eligible participant assigned a dollar amount to be calculated by taking the total number of participants divided by the total amount of available funding. Clubs will then be provided with a participant subsidy based on the total number of participants by club multiplied by the previously calculated per player subsidy.

**Eligible Participants (Under 12)** – All participants 18 years of age or younger, as of August 1<sup>st</sup>, included by an approved facility on the Golf Canada Junior Skills Challenge Leaderboard will be eligible for a per player subsidy.

• **Under 12 Participants** - The per player subsidy for Under 12 participants will not exceed \$7.50 per participant, with the total subsidy for clubs not exceeding \$2,500 in Per Player Funding.

For example, if there is \$3,000 available for Under 12 participant subsidies, and there are 500 total participants, then each facility will receive their base funding, plus \$6.00 for each Under 12 participant.

• Under 19 Participants – In order to be eligible for a Per Player Subsidy, those players between the ages of 12 and 18 years of age MUST be members in good standing of Golf NB & Golf Canada. The per player subsidy for eligible Under 19 participants will not exceed \$12.50 per participant, with the total subsidy for clubs not exceeding \$2,500 in Per Player Funding.

For example, if there is \$2,000 available for Under 18 participant subsidies, and there are 250 eligible participants (i.e., Members of Golf NB & Golf Canada), then each facility will receive their base funding, plus \$8.00 for each Under 19 participant.

The total per player subsidy for clubs will not exceed \$1,250 in Per Player Funding.
